GETTING TO CASTLEBAR

Castlebar is situated County Mayo in the west of Ireland. The main airports in Ireland are Dublin & Shannon, both have regular flight to the continent of Europe and USA.. [Aer Lingus](#) direct flights from New York, Los Angeles, Washington, Dallas, Boston.. Daily flights with [Ryanair](#) between London Stansted and [Knock Airport](#). (30 minute drive from Castlebar). Aer Arann operate a daily flight between Dublin and Knock

Ferry terminals with sailings to and from France and the UK at Rosslare and Cork.

Travelling from Dublin, take the N4 west to Longford and then join the N5 to Castlebar (time by car 3 hours). From the Northwest, join the N16 to Sligo, then the N4 to Charlestown and then the N5 to Castlebar. From the South, join the N18 at Limerick to Oranmore, then the N64 and N17 to Claremorris and finally the N60 to Castlebar. From the Southeast, join the N61 at Athlone bypass and then N60 to Roscommon.
